Improvers' Spanish Part 1

Required starting level

This course is designed for students who have completed our Beginners' Spanish course or who have a grounding in basic Spanish and would like to progress and further develop their confidence, skills and knowledge.

Aims

The aim is to consolidate and extend students' knowledge of the vocabulary and basic grammar needed to deal with everyday situations in a Spanish-speaking country. Students will be encouraged to read aloud, pronounce the words correctly and reinforce their learning by writing exercises.

Working methods/types of activities

- Whole group activities and working in pairs
- Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking practice
- CD/PowerPoint resources, as appropriate
- Exploration of grammar
- Games and quizzes
