Intermediate Spanish Part 1 and 2

Aims

This course is designed for students who have completed our Improvers Spanish course, and for those who feel their Spanish is somewhat rusty and wish to re-visit and develop their knowledge of grammar. The course aims to consolidate and expand your vocabulary and understanding of the Spanish language and culture.

Working methods/types of activities

- Reading and discussing books and articles about Spanish culture as reading offers the opportunity of comprehension and correct pronunciation.
- Time is set aside for conversation practice.
- Most weeks, notes are given out to help the revision of grammatical points.
