

SUMMER WORK FOR INCOMING YEAR 12 MUSIC

It is essential that students studying music in the Sixth Form have an appropriate level of THEORY knowledge before they begin. As a general rule – Grade 5 theory is a basic requirement. If you do not have this then the list below will tell you what you should learn/revise this summer. If you do have Grade 5 theory, then check that you can still remember what you learned for it!

- Secure reading of bass and treble clefs.
- Secure knowledge of all key signatures (major and minor).
- Secure knowledge of the make-up of a major or minor triad (key note, third and fifth) – on any note.
