All information you provide will of course be treated in confidence (according to the school's policies and procedures) but will enable us to put in appropriate support if necessary and hopefully ease your son's transition into secondary school life. If you have already given our Admissions Officer this information for the 11 plus, this will have already been sent through to me, so there is no need to resend it.

To begin with, the information you provide will be put on your son's personal file and shared with the Heads of School, the SENCo and his form tutor. It will only be circulated more widely if appropriate.
